## New Features

1. Hypertext links added (expanded). **Altogether 455,000 hypertext links to various books.**
2. **Encyclopedias – Biographies of Talmudic rabbis** and information about their teachers and disciples; **Encyclopedia of Talmudical concepts** – 5000 entries of Talmudic foundations, rules, and concepts, explained in a clear and easy style; **Encyclopedia of Holiday Customs** contains definitions and brief descriptions of numerous customs related to Jewish holidays
3. **Dictionaries – Abbreviations** (independent dictionary, integrated in the search mechanism, and dictionary related to text expansion); **Aramaic - Hebrew** (independent dictionary, integrated in the search mechanism, dictionary related to text translation).
4. **Tutorials** - Responsa features several help tutorials to help you master the program's main features. The complete version in Hebrew contains:
  - Different search examples using a variety of search tools (available in English too)
  - Links, references for quick information, personal notes and links, indexes
  - Preparation of a Sugiya
  - Frequently Asked Questions (available in English too)
5. Display of Minchat Shai with Trop (in Windows Vista and Windows 7)
6. Specify databases in the search by typing in their names, rather than clicking on the Database tree
7. Option to display biographies and entries from the encyclopedia of Talmudic concepts directly from Responsa texts
8. Commentaries - display the titles of the commentary, skip to a particular commentary, printing the title of the particular commentary, Option to choose more than one commentary for a specific text.
9. Option to change the margins and line spacing of texts in Responsa windows.
10. Option to highlight all results when searching for text in text and expanded display windows, in addition to search forwards and backwards
11. Option to select books and databases from which hyperlinked texts (cross-references) are displayed; and customizing options for displaying hyperlinked texts on particular passages.
12. Option to bookmark texts in text windows and expanded display windows.
13. Bookmarks can be saved and displayed in the Personal Notes Manager.
